What the law requires in regard to attendance reporting in church schools: 16-28-8

All school officers, including those in private schools, or private tutors, but not those in church schools, in the state offering instruction to pupils within the compulsory attendance ages, shall make and furnish all reports that may be required by the State Superintendent of Education and by the county superintendent of education or by the board of education of any city reference to the workings of this article. The principal teacher of each public school private school, church school and each private tutor shall keep an attendance register showing the enrollment of the school and every absence of each enrolled child from school for a half day or more during each school day of each year

Absence must be explained. Every parent, guardian, or other person having control or charge of any child required to attend public school, private school, or church school, shall as soon as practical explain the cause of any absence of the child under his/her control or charge which was without which was without permission of the teacher, and a failure to furnish such explanation shall be admissible as evidence of such child being truant with the consent and connivance of the person in control or charge of said child, unless such person can show the reasonable satisfaction of the court that he/she had no knowledge of such absence and that he/she has been diligent in their efforts to secure the attendance of such child.
